The mission of the Edmond Quilt Guild is to preserve, teach and share the history and art of quilting

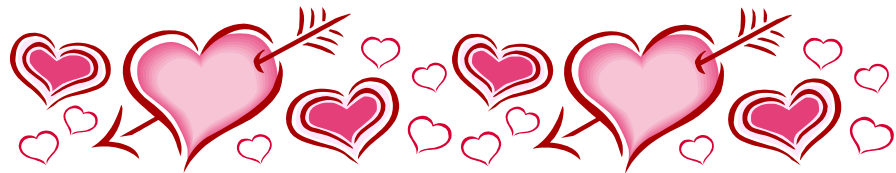


## President's Report— Laura James

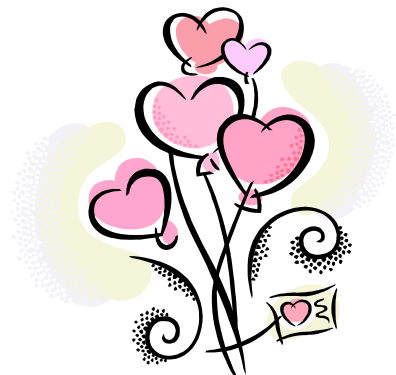

Easy Speedy T-shirt Quilt Workshop

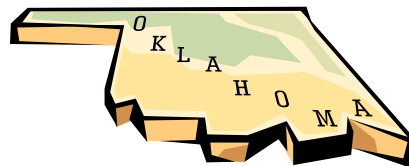
Join us Saturday March 10th from 9am to 4pm in the Potter's Room at Memorial Road Church of Christ. We'll be using fusible batting instead of interfacing to stabilize the blocks for quilting, which is done BEFORE they are joined. Seam allowances go to the back of the quilt where they are clipped and curl into short, soft fringe when the quilt is washed. 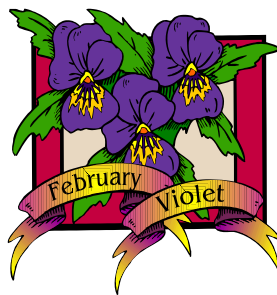

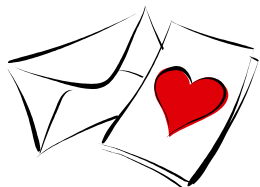

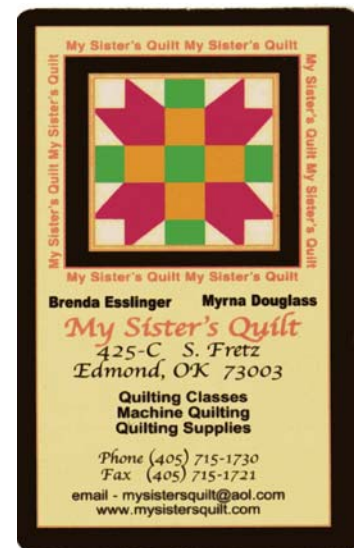
