



# Katrina Quilt Instruction Sheet

Cut strips from your favorite (or least favorite) color - red, blue, purple, green. Select a strip size:  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " ,  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " and cut the same width strips

across as many fabrics as you like. Length of strips does not matter. So that means you can cut up scraps, fat quarters, whatever. Take this opportunity to clean out your stash. Now, take those strips and sew them end to end. Yep, end to end, so you have a huge long strip of fabric,



then roll it up. Each roll should be the same color the same width. Make as many as you want, get your any board member, or come to our sew ins at 6:00


Our goal is to complete as many twin size quilts as we can between now and Thanksgiving.
