

2024 EQG QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES WITH DEFINITIONS

MASTERS Categories: (anyone who has been awarded 3 1st place ribbons in the same category or who has received a National Award)

Pieced Quilts: Large or Small

Applique Quilts: Large or Small

Mixed Techniques: Large or Small

ARTISAN Categories

Pieced Quilts: 1 person Large, Medium, or Small
2 persons Large, Medium, or Small

Applique Quilts: 1 person Large or Small
2 persons Large or Small

Mixed Technique: 1 person Large or Small
2 persons Large or Small

COMBINED ARTISAN and MASTER Category:

Group Quilts: (3 or more persons, known or not, whose work contributed to the completion of the quilt).

Art, Pictorial, Innovative: (Representative of a person, place, or thing; an original design reflective of the creativity of the artist).

Large or Small

Children's: (A child-themed quilt made specially FOR a child, not by a child. Child is defined as newborn to 18 years)

Large or Small

BOM or Kit:(Only applies where the fabric is provided. This category is not eligible for Best of Show award and will only be judged on workmanship.)

First Time Entrant:(An entrant who has not entered any previous quilt show)

Large or Small

2024 EQG QUILT SHOW CATEGORIES WITH DEFINITIONS

Mixed Techniques: A quilt with equal amounts of two major techniques in the quilt. For example, a quilt with both pieced and applique. A combination of hand and machine quilting would not be considered mixed techniques.

EQG Challenge Quilts: These quilts will not count toward the show entry limit. A Celebrity will judge and choose the winner. These quilts cannot be entered in other categories.

Awards

First, Second, Third Place and Honorable Mention awards will be given at the Judges' sole discretion in each category. If a category has only 1 entrant any ribbons will be awarded at the Judges' sole discretion.

Special Awards: Best Hand Quilting; Best of Show; Judges Choice (2); Viewers' Choice.

Special Ribbon: Challenge and Founder's

of Entries: In anticipation of the number of entries submitted we are limiting the total to **2 per entrant**. EQG always wants to display our full talent and wants everyone to have a chance. However, if we fall short of our numbers, we may ask for additional quilts.

of Entries per Category: An entrant can only enter one quilt in the same category. The entrant can enter quilts in different categories.

Quilt size: Size of a quilt is determined by the perimeter measurements.
A Large quilt perimeter is 240" or larger.
A Small quilt perimeter is 239" or less.

1 person: quilt is both sewn and quilted by the same person

2 persons: quilts are sewn by one person then quilted by another person.

Category Determination: Choosing the appropriate category can be difficult. If you are unsure, please contact Alice Kellogg, Display Chairman, (405-348-2233) for assistance. If Alice feels you have entered an incorrect category, she will contact the entrant either by email or phone call to discuss your options. For example, should a quilt be entered in Applique or Mixed techniques. It could be both, depending on many factors. But once you and/or Alice, have decided where your quilt is to be entered, it will not be changed.
